What is an Offensive Incident?

An offensive incident is any incident which is felt by you or any other person to be the result of hate or prejudice, based on Gender, Race, Religion, Disability, Age, Sexual Orientation or other factors.

Offensive behaviour includes things like abusive language, physical assault, graffiti, bullying and damage to property.

What is important is that the behaviour is unreasonable, unwelcome and offensive.
